

Dealing With Divorce

What you need to know about divorce.

- Not all divorce is the same, but all divorce is life-changing.
- “Divorce is a life transforming experience. After divorce, childhood is different. Adolescence is different. Adulthood-with the decision to marry or not and have children or not –is different. Whether the final outcome is good or bad, the whole trajectory of an individual’s life is profoundly altered by the divorce experience”

What does Scripture say about divorce?

- “And this second thing you do. You cover the LORD's altar with tears, with weeping and groaning because he no longer regards the offering or accepts it with favor from your hand. ¹⁴ But you say, “Why does he not?” Because the LORD was witness between you and the wife of your youth, to whom you have been faithless, though she is your companion and your wife by covenant. ¹⁵ Did he not make them one, with a portion of the Spirit in their union? And what was the one God seeking? Godly offspring. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and let none of you be faithless to the wife of your youth. ¹⁶ “For the man who does not love his wife but divorces her, says the LORD, the God of Israel, covers his garment with violence, says the LORD of hosts. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and do not be faithless.”.

What does Scripture say about divorce?

- And Pharisees came up to him and tested him by asking, “Is it lawful to divorce one’s wife for any cause?”⁴ He answered, “Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female,⁵ and said, ‘Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh’?⁶ So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.”⁷ They said to him, “Why then did Moses command one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?”⁸ He said to them, “Because of your hardness of heart Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so.⁹ And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery.”

A warning for children of divorce.

- Your parents' divorce does not give you a license to rebel.
- If you try to deal with the pain, hurt, and anger on your own it will consume you.
- Statistics suggest that you are more likely to either never marry or to also have a failed marriage.

Hope for children of divorce.

This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. However let each one of you love his wife as himself and let the wife see that she respects her husband.” Ephesians 5:31-33

- ① You can learn from both the good and the bad of your parents' marriage to strengthen your own marriage one day.
